

Institutional Disclosures Required by State Authorization of Distance Education Final Regulations

An institution that offers an educational program through distance education or correspondence

Individualized Disclosures

Upon any determination by the institution that the program does not meet licensure or certification prerequisites in the State of the institution, the institution shall disclose the following information to each enrolled and prospective student:

To each enrolled and prospective student:

- Any adverse action initiated by a State or an accrediting agency related to postsecondary education programs offered by the institution solely through distance education or correspondence study within 30 days of the institution becoming aware of such action;
- Any determination by the institution that the program ceases to meet licensure or certification prerequisites of a State within 14 calendar days of that determination.

For a prospective student who received a disclosure who subsequently enrolls in the program, the institution must receive acknowledgment from that student that the student received the disclosure and be able to demonstrate the student's acknowledgment.
